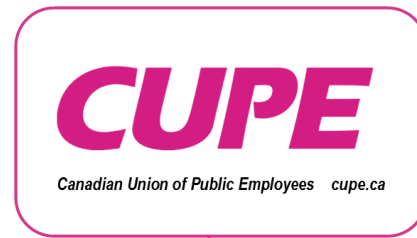

Are You a Card-Carrying Member of CUPE 3550? Do You Know Where Your Membership Card Is? Do You Need a Replacement Card?

By submitting your membership application with your \$2.00 initiation fee you are entitled to a membership card which allows you full voice and vote on union decisions. These decisions are made at general or special meetings held throughout the year.

In order to receive your membership card you must be sworn in by a table officer of CUPE 3550.

You can be sworn in at a membership meeting or make an appointment at the CUPE Local 3550 office. Membership meetings are held the first Tuesday of every month at the Central Lions Senior Centre (11113-113 Street NW Edmonton) at 7 P.M.

Our next membership meeting is **Tuesday, February 7th**.

If you cannot attend a membership meeting and wish to be sworn in at the union office it is important you call ahead to ensure a union representative is available.

Your CUPE Local 3550 Membership Card entitles you to the following privileges:

- voting rights on your Collective Agreement and the decisions of your local.
- invitations to monthly and/or special membership meetings where decisions, which directly affect Support Staff, are made.
- the ability to run for elected positions.
- become a delegate of your union and attend conferences, workshops, and education opportunities.
- attend CUPE Local 3550 special events such as the Kid's Christmas Party.
